- 4. SPECIAL NOTE: Registration deadline is AUGUST 15, 2020. Mailed or faxed registration forms received after the deadline will NOT be processed; staff will be preparing to leave for NAFOW.
- 5. Festival passes and tickets may be purchased online at www.NAFOW.org until August 31, 2020.
- 6. Advance purchase is recommended, tickets are first-come, first-served basis. Your Festival packets will then be available for pick up on-site. The on-site registration desk opens **4:30 pm, Wednesday, September 2, 2020**.
- 7. No refunds for the NAFOW will be issued after **August 1, 2020**, except for extenuating circumstances. A \$25 non-refundable fee to cover administrative costs will apply and amounts under \$25 will not be refunded.

### **2020 NAFOW Tour Descriptions**

#### 1. Thursday, September 3, 2020, Welsh Tract Tour: Early Welsh Settlement in America

*Price*: \$90.00, *Entrance fees and catered lunch are included in the price*.

Assemble at 7:45am in the hotel lobby, tour will leave by 8:00am, and return around 4:00pm.

William Penn and the 17<sup>th</sup> century Welsh Settlers of Pennsylvania had ambitious plans for a Welsh home in the new world free from the religious persecution they often experienced back home. Join us on a daylong journey to the picturesque area of suburban Philadelphia that was known as the Welsh Tract or Welsh Barony. Here Welsh-speaking Quakers and later Baptists and Anglicans found a new home to call their own. To this day, many communities' names, such as Merion, Bala, Haverford and Bryn Mawr, bear witness to their Welsh heritage. Highlights of the tour will include stops at an early Welsh homestead (the original "Bryn Mawr" estate), an early Welsh church (St. Davids Episcopal Church, Radnor), and Washington Memorial Chapel in the heart of Valley Forge National Historical Park. Lunch will be enjoyed amidst the lush surroundings of the Merion Cricket Club.

#### 2. Thursday, September 3, Highlights of Center City Philadelphia Walking Tour: City Hall, Masonic Temple

Price: \$35. Lunch on your own, plenty of options in Cedarburg. Assemble at 8:15 in the hotel lobby, tour will leave by 8:30am. Return by 2:30pm.

Our second Thursday tour has something for everyone! We depart the hotel in the morning for our first stop in Cedarburg, about 20 miles north of Milwaukee, for a guided tour of the Wisconsin Museum of Quilts and Fiber Arts. The museum, housed in a fascinating restored barn, offers a guided tour and a special display of two Welsh quilts, including a wedding quilt, and an exhibit on the theme of "Water" that features works in fiber arts by local Wisconsin artists. Moving to historic downtown Cedarburg, we will have time to explore unique shops, inns, cafes, art galleries and museums, with lunch on our own. A short drive in the afternoon to Hartford, Wisconsin and we arrive at the Wisconsin Automotive Museum, Wisconsin's largest auto museum. It features a rotating display of classic and vintage autos, and the largest assembled group of Hartford-built Kissel luxury automobiles (circa 1906-1931). *Note: Some of the historic buildings in Cedarburg are not fully accessible*.

#### 3. Monday, September 7, 2020, Longwood Gardens and Brandywine Valley

Price: \$100. Entry fees, transportation and lunch included in the price. Assemble at 8:15am, leaves 8:30. Return 6:30pm Join us on a memorable day in the heart of the Brandywine Valley in beautiful Southeastern Pennsylvania. We'll begin our day with a visit to world-renowned Longwood Gardens, one of North America's loveliest and most extensive botanical gardens and fountain displays. We will have lunch onsite. Our afternoon will include a scenic drive with a short visit to one of the area's other numerous attractions, such as a winery or historic site before returning to Philadelphia.
