- Festival attendees will be invited to adjudicate via secret ballot, one vote per person to choose one submitted piece. Artists will remain anonymous throughout the voting process.
- Via the online entry form, please provide a title and short description of your piece, along with estimated maximum dimensions (length x width x height), no later than **August 22, 2022**. Only one piece per person will be accepted.
- This year, there is no restriction as to when the piece was created. However, no entrant may submit a piece that was previously submitted to this competition, in 2019 (Milwaukee) or 2021 (Utica).
- There is no entry fee for this competition.
- Prizes (in US dollars) are: Winner: \$75. Second place: \$50. Third place: \$25.
- Owing to potential space restrictions, the Eisteddfod Committee reserves the right to place a cap on the number of entries, at its discretion, prior to the deadline. You will receive confirmation from the Committee, via email, if your entry is accepted for the competition.
- Receipt of accepted pieces for entry, and their installation, will take place on **Friday, Sept. 2**nd, **between 10:00 AM and 3:30 PM**, at the hotel and in a room specified at Festival Registration.
- Display of the entered pieces, for popular viewing and adjudication, will take place at the hotel **between 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM on Saturday, Sept. 3rd.** Prize winners will be announced on Sunday, Sept. 4th, at the Gymanfa Ganu (Church of the Redeemer, Bryn Mawr, PA).
